RE: Update – Flyers Drive/Wayne Street Sewer Construction Project (38 Flyers Drive)

Dear NPU Customer,

Since my last update, we've made some significant progress in moving the sewer installation project for your neighborhood forward. Here is the latest information:

Awarding of Construction Contract

The project's lowest bidder is Nutmeg Gravel & Excavation, Inc (NGE). In spite of inflation and other increases in construction costs, we were pleased that the NGE's bid came within 1% of our original cost projections back in 2006.

Construction to Begin

NPU will be signing the contract with NGE Thursday May 24, 2009 and construction will begin soon after. While there are many things which can affect a construction schedule, our goal is to complete our work before colder weather arrives. We know that any construction involving digging and the removal of pavement is difficult at best. Unfortunately there will be some traffic interruptions associated with the work. Please be patient and be assured that we work closely with our contractors to minimize disruptions. Our objective is to ensure that construction moves effectively, efficiently, and safely.


Interested in Natural Gas?
